### Qualifications for Entry

For Pointers and Setters which have won a First or Second award in Open Stakes or a First award in an Open Breed Stake since 30 July 2024.

The Winner and Runner-up in the 2024 and 2025 Champion Stakes and The Winner of the 2026 Royal Kennel Club Puppy Derby Stake are entitled to run.

The 2025 Winner of the Irish Championship for Pointers and Setters is eligible to compete.

The winner of the Partridge Challenge Stake 2026 is eligible to compete.

The foregoing awards must have been gained in a stake qualifying for entry in The Royal Kennel Club Stud Book. Awards must be clearly stated on the entry form.

The Champion Stake will be held over two days with an unlimited number of entrants. In the event of there being less than 40 entries, the organising club will have the discretion to run the Championship over one day instead of two.

### Entry Fee

£20 per entry If paying by cheque, a separate cheque required for each entry. Fees must accompany entries.

Competitors paying by Bank Transfer must pay at the time of submitting their entry.

**Please read the following information carefully**

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Kennel Club Registration:** All dogs that have qualified must be registered at The Royal Kennel Club in accordance with The Royal Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. Any dog that has qualified and is resident outside the UK must have obtained and been issued with a Royal Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the Champion Stake. An entrant found not to have complied will be excluded from competing in the Champion Stake.

**Entry Form:** Please complete your entry form in *legible* block capitals, ensuring that you include Awards gained.

**Entry Fees:** If paying by cheque, a **separate cheque** is required for **each entry**. Fees must accompany entries.

**Ownership:** Please ensure that details of ownership are correct. If the dog is owned in partnership, **all** owners must be named. If you have applied to The Royal Kennel Club for transfer of ownership, please write TAF (transfer applied for) after the dog's name.

**Stud Book Number:** Please use a Stud Book number where appropriate in place of Registration number.

**Return of Entry Fees:** The Royal Kennel Club rule J6.f applies.

Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to The Royal Kennel Club at the earliest opportunity.

No modification will be made to this Schedule except by permission of The Royal Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.

Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.

All competitors and spectators attending the trial must consider themselves under the orders of the officials and must follow closely behind the flagman.

Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host.

Trophy holders please ensure that **clean** trophies are returned in time for the trial.

**WELFARE OF DOGS**

Competitors whose dogs are entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure that the needs of their dogs are met and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under The Royal Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
